Violations of Online Written Assessment

The College of Medicine and Medical Sciences (CMMS) is striving to help students do their exams under optimum conditions and protect online assessment integrity. The following are the violations of the rules and regulations of online exams. If student commits any one of these violations, he/she will be considered to have committed cheating and will be subjected to the penalties according to the AGU Bylaws.

1. Failure to show full face on exam video at all times.
2. Off-screen gaze (looking outside the screen) at any time.
3. Failure to start exam within 10 minutes of sending exam password without a valid technical reason verified by the CMMS technical team.
4. Leaving the camera field at any time during exam.
5. Having direct light at the background that causes the face to be dark.
6. Talking to any one during exam.
7. Reading questions or answers loudly.
8. Communicating with anyone through any means such as mobile phone or any other electronic device.
9. Presence of another person/s in the room with the student.
10. Recording or taking photos for exams in part or in full.
11. Using pen, paper, calculator, mobile phone, tablet or any other device (other than the laptop you use for exam).
12. Connecting the device to another screen.
13. Failure to upload exam video in full after exam.
14. Using wireless or wired headphones
15. Wearing head cover such as cap (except Hijab for girls).
